- Zero Based Budgeting Review Bonnie presented a high level spreadsheet of the zero based budgeting for DCSD departments.
- Phishing Attack Bonnie Betz informed the committee of a phishing attack in which the

 department and Business Service staff, no employees were affected.
- SCOTUS Endrew Ruling The Supreme Court ruled unanimously to set a new legal standard that schools throughout the country must meet to educate students with special needs. The Supreme Court Justices did not say that DCSD lost the case; they simply sent

- the Endrew case back to the lower courts where it will be reconsidered with this new standard in mind. At this time, there is no financial burden to the District.
