SB 09-163

(22-11-302 (b)) ADVISE ITS LOCAL SCHOOL BOARD CONCERNING PREPARATION OF, AND ANNUALLY SUBMIT TO THE LOCAL SCHOOL BOARD RECOMMENDATIONS REGARDING THE CONTENTS OF A DISTRICT PERFORMANCE PLAN



Performance Frameworks

- Colorado's accountability system - Education Accountability Act of 2009, (SB 09-163)
- Issued for each district and school
- Provides information about how districts and schools performed on the same set of indicators and measures



Changes for 2016 - 17

- **New Performance Frameworks**
 - Targets (Graduation, Dropout etc.)
 - Growth Data
 - Data Weighting
 - Matriculation Rates
 - Disaggregated Achievement
 - Cut Scores

Accountability (2016-17)

- School plan types and district accreditation ratings were assigned by CDE in 2016
- Each district that is accredited or accredited with distinct can submit biennial plans
- Each school that is on a performance plan can submit biennial plans
- Accountability clock is applicable



Accountability (2016-17)

- Annual submission for certain programs still required (i.e. ESEA, READ Act, Gifted)
- Timeline for submission is same
- School Leadership will decide plan submission timeline
